Information from the MAG SMC meeting held 20 July 2006

- **State MAG SMC Minutes**

In order for the National SMC to be kept informed of what is happening in the sport at a state level, State Technical Directors are requested to email a copy of the State SMC minutes to the National Program Manager.

- **On-Line Risk Management Course**

All MAG Technical Members are reminded that the GA On-Line Risk Management Course must be completed by the end of the year for Technical Membership renewal in 2007.

- **New Zealand Open Tour – September 2006**

Kath Graham reported that all tour organization is being finalised by Megan Currie at the GA office. A circular will be sent to all tour members in the near future.

- **MAG Club/Program Tour Guidelines**

The SMC agreed to introduce the MAG Club/Program Tour Guidelines for all MAG international tours not organized by Gymnastics Australia. Clubs and Programs must request sanction from the National SMC if they intend to compete at international events. These Tour Guidelines can be found on the MAG website.

- **Junior Clinic and AYOF Training Camp**

Kath Graham will be making contact with the State SMCs and coaches to find out what they are wanting from the clinic and the camp. Kath will then put forward recommendations to the National SMC for discussion

- **Team Selection for World Cup Events**

Tim Quinlivan reported that a request for expressions of interest in the World Cup events was emailed to the EMC coaches.

Shanghai World Cup: 3 gymnasts and 2 coaches attended
DTB Stuttgart World Cup: 7 expressions of interest have been received. The Provisional Entry has been sent to the event organizers.

Glasgow World Cup: 1 expression of interest received.

- **MAG Selection Policy and Event Criteria**

The National SMC is currently reformatting the 2006-2007 MAG Selection Policy and Event Criteria based on a template produced by the GA Board of Management. The agreed changes to the event criteria made at the EMC meeting in May will be included in the document and then sent to the GA Board for endorsement.

- **2006 MAG National Club Championships**

Bob Morton reported that the event was a success even though the number of gymnasts competing was down compared to previous years. Thanks to ACT Gymnastics for hosting this event. The 2007 National Club Championships will be held in December.

- **AIS/GA Olympic Squad Training Camp**

The AIS/GA Olympic Squad Training Camp will be held on the 1st-8th September 2006 at the AIS in Canberra.

- **2006 World Championships Selection Trial**

The World Championships Selection Trial will be held at the AIS on the 8th and 10th September 2006. Please note that entries close on the 31st July 2006.

- **2008 Olympic Selection Criteria**

The National SMC will prepare the first draft of the MAG Olympic Selection criteria and email it to the EMC coaches for comment.

- **AYOF Selection Trial**

Gymnastics Queensland has approved the hosting of the AYOF Selection Trial at the GQ State Training Centre, Chandler. The preliminary schedule will be as follows:

Saturday 2nd December: Training after 2.00pm

Sunday 3rd December: Warm-up 10.00am competition to commence at 11.30am.

Accommodation for teams and officials will be at Chandler Lodge.

- **MAG Planning Meeting & National Program Review**

The National SMC will be holding a Planning Meeting and a National Program Review on the 9th September at the AIS in Canberra.

- **MAG Community Survey**

Bob Morton will prepare a MAG Survey and present it to the National SMC for comment before emailing it out to the Clubs and Coaches.
