

2008/2009 NATIONAL SQUADS
Junior, Senior, AIS/GA Olympic Squad, 2010 Junior Development Squad

2008/2009 Junior National Squad

(Squad term 30 May 2008 – 30 May 2009)

1. Eligibility :

- 1.1 Subject to clause 1.2 in order to be eligible for selection to the 2008/2009 Junior National Squad an athlete must:
- (a) have achieved a minimum score of 106.00pts (2 days combined) at one of the selection events set out in paragraph 2.1 (**Nominated Selection Events**) ; and,
 - (b) be a maximum of 15 years of age or younger in the year of competition; and,
 - (c) have participated in one of the Nominated Selection Events
- 1.2 If an athlete has not met any of the eligibility requirements set out in paragraphs (a) and (c) above the athlete may still be eligible if:
- (a) the athlete is a Special Consideration athlete as per the Selection Policy (Part A - Article 5.7).
 - (b) the athlete is an Additional Athlete as per the Selection Policy (Part A - Article 6.1).

2. Nominated Selection Events :

- 2.1
- a) 2008 Australian Championships 20 – 25 May 2008
 - b) 2008 National Clubs Championships 28 November – 14 December 2008
 - c) 2008 GA Selection trials – dates to be advised

3. Selection:

- 4.1 Any athlete who has met the minimum score required by paragraph 1.1(a).
- 4.2 When considering Special Consideration Athlete(s) and/or Additional Athlete(s), the Selection Committee may consider all or some of the following factors (not listed in any order of priority) and may give such weight to any or all of these factors as the Selection Committee in its complete discretion sees fit:
- (i) Performances at Nominated Selection Event(s)
 - (ii) Past National & International results (over the preceding 6 months)
 - (iii) Possible team composition and possible individual all-around or individual apparatus medals during the term of the squad
 - (iv) Training consistency and demonstrated athlete attitude and behaviour

PART B National Squad Criteria – Women’s Artistic Gymnastics

2008/2009 Senior National Squad

(Squad term 30 May 2008 – 30 May 2009)

1. Eligibility :

1.1 Subject to clause 1.2 in order to be eligible for selection to the 2008/2009 Senior National Squad an athlete must:

(a) have achieved a minimum score of 110.00pts All Around (2 days combined) at one of the selection events set out in paragraph 2.1 (**Nominated Selection Events**)

or an A' score of 5.80 on either day on Vault at one of the selection events set out in paragraph 2.1 (**Nominated Selection Events**)

or an “A” score of 15.00 pts on either day on uneven bars, balance beam or floor exercise at one of the selection events set out in paragraph 2.1 (**Nominated Selection Events**) ;

and,

(b) be a minimum of 16 years of age or older in the year of competition; and,

(c) have participated in one of the Nominated Selection Events

1.2 If a athlete has not met any of the eligibility requirements set out in paragraphs (a) and (c) above the athlete may still be eligible if:

(a) the athlete is a Special Consideration athlete as per the Selection Policy (Part A - Article 5.7).

(b) the athlete is an Additional Athlete as per the Selection Policy (Part A - Article 6.1).

2. Nominated Selection Events :

- a) 2008 Australian Championships 20 - 25 May 2008
 - b) 2008 National Clubs Championships 28 November – 14 December 2008
 - c) 2008 GA Selection trials – dates to be advised

3. Selection:

4.1 Any athlete who has met the minimum score required by paragraph 1.1(a).

4.2 When considering Special Consideration Athlete(s) and/or Additional Athlete(s), the Selection Committee may consider all or some of the following factors (not listed in any order of priority) and may give such weight to any or all of these factors as the Selection Committee in its complete discretion sees fit:

- (i) Performances at Nominated Selection Event(s)
- (ii) Past National & International results (over the preceding 6 months)

- (iii) Possible team composition and possible individual all-around or individual apparatus medals during the term of the squad
- (iv) Training consistency and demonstrated athlete attitude and behaviour

PART B National Squad Criteria – Women’s Artistic Gymnastics

2008/2009 AIS/GA Olympic Squad

(Squad terms 30 May 2008 – 15 Dec 2008 / 15 Dec 2009 – 30 May 2010)

1. Eligibility :

1.1 Subject to clause 1.2 in order to be eligible for selection to the 2008/2009 AIS/GA Olympic Squad an athlete must:

- (a) be either a Junior or Senior National Squad Member ; and,
- (b) have participated in the Nominated Selection Event

1.2 If an athlete has not met any of the eligibility requirements set out in paragraphs (a) and (b) above the athlete may still be eligible if the athlete is a Special Consideration athlete as per the Selection Policy (Part A - Article 5.7).

2. Nominated Selection Events :

- 2.1
 - a) 2008 Australian Championships 20 - 25 May 2008
 - b) 2008 National Club Championships 28 November – 14 December 2008

2.2 It is a condition of selection that an athlete attends the compulsory AIS/GA Olympic Squad Training Camps (Full Camps Based Scholarship Holders – 2 camps per Squad Term and Visiting Athletes each camp they are selected for), unless an athlete has had an application for special consideration in relation to that Training Camp accepted by the Selection Committee (Part A – Article 5).

3. Squad Size:

- 3.1 Up to 10 athletes will be selected to the AIS/GA Olympic Squad
- 3.2
 - (a) up to 7 athletes will be named as “AIS Camp Based Scholarship” holders
 - (b) Up to 3 athletes will be named for each AIS/GA Olympic Squad Camp, being “Visiting Athletes”

4. Selection:

- 4.1
 - (a) top 4 ranked athletes (2008 age eligible) from the 2008 Australian Championships (2 days combined), provided National Squad qualification score has been met.
 - (b) should fewer than 4 athletes meet the National Squad Qualification Score, the WAG Selection Committee may appoint athlete(s) to the remaining positions considering all or some of the following factors (not listed in any order of priority) and may give such weight to any or all of these factors as the Selection Committee in its complete discretion sees fit:

- (i) Performances at nominated selection event(s)
 - (ii) Past National & International results (over the preceding 6 months)
 - (iii) Possible future team composition and possible individual apparatus medals
 - (iv) Training consistency and demonstrated athlete attitude and behaviour
 - (v) Any accepted special consideration applications
- 4.2 up to 3 athletes appointed at the discretion of the WAG Selection Committee. When appointing athletes to these positions the Selection Committee may consider all or some of the following factors (not listed in any order of priority) and may give such weight to any or all of these factors as the Selection Committee in its complete discretion sees fit:
- (i) Performances at nominated selection event(s)
 - (ii) Past National & International results (over the preceding 6 months)
 - (iii) Possible future team composition and possible individual all-around or individual apparatus medals
 - (iv) Training consistency and demonstrated athlete attitude and behaviour
 - (v) Any accepted special consideration applications
- 4.3 up to 3 athletes to be appointed for each camp, being ‘Visiting Athletes’. The WAG Selection Committee may appoint athlete(s) to the remaining positions considering all or some of the following factors (not listed in any order of priority) and may give such weight to any or all of these factors as the Selection Committee in its complete discretion sees fit:
- (i) Performances at nominated selection event(s)
 - (ii) Past National & International results (over the preceding 6 months)
 - (iii) Possible future team composition and possible individual all-around or individual apparatus medals
 - (iv) Training consistency and demonstrated athlete attitude and behaviour
 - (v) Any accepted special consideration applications

5. AIS/GA Olympic Squad Review:

The Selection Committee reserves the right to review the squad at the 2008 National Club Championships (28 November – 14 December 2008), considering all or some of the following factors (not listed in any order of priority) and may give such weight to any or all of these factors as the Selection Committee in its complete discretion sees fit:

- (i) Performances at nominated selection event(s)
- (ii) Past National & International results (over the preceding 6 months)
- (iii) Possible future team composition and possible individual all-around or individual apparatus medals
- (iv) Training consistency and demonstrated athlete attitude and behaviour
- (v) Any accepted special consideration applications

PART B National Squad Criteria – Women’s Artistic Gymnastics

Attendance at the National Clubs Championships event is compulsory for all AIS/GA Olympic Squad members and any athlete vying for selection in to this squad unless granted an exemption by the Selection Committee or accepted application for special consideration in accordance with Article 5 - Part A Selection Policy.

2010 Junior Development Squad – Final Dec 2007

(Squad terms 30 December 2007 – 30 May 2008 / 30 May 2008 – 30 Dec 2008)

1. Eligibility :

- 1.1 Subject to clause 1.2 in order to be eligible for selection to the 2010 Junior Development Squad an athlete must:
- (a) be either a Junior International, International Level 10 or International Level 8 athlete ; and,
 - (b) have participated in the Nominated Selection Event
- 1.2 If an athlete has not met any of the eligibility requirements set out in paragraphs (a) and (b) above the athlete may still be eligible if the athlete is a Special Consideration athlete as per the Selection Policy (Part A - Article 5.7).

2. Nominated Selection Events :

- 2.1
- a) 2007 National Club Championships 28 November – 14 December 2008
 - b) 2008 Australian Championships 20 – 25 May 2008 or 2008 National Championships 5 – 13 July 2008
- 2.2 It is a condition of selection that an athlete attends the compulsory 2010 Junior Development Squad Training Camps (Full squad members – 2 camps per Squad Term and Visiting Athletes each camp they are selected for), unless an athlete has had an application for special consideration in relation to that Training Camp accepted by the Selection Committee (Part A – Article 5).

3. Squad Size:

- 3.1 Up to 16 athletes will be selected to the 2010 Junior Development Squad
- 3.2
- (a) up to 12 athletes will be named as “Full” squad members
 - (b) Up to 4 athletes will be named for each 2010 Development Squad Camp, being “Visiting Athletes”

4. Selection:

- 4.1 any Junior International Squad member will automatically qualify for the 2010 Junior Development Squad, provided the National Junior Squad Score has been reached at the Nomination Selection event at which the selection is taking place.
- 4.2 the remaining athletes up to 12 (depending on the number of automatically qualified athletes) will be appointed at the discretion of the WAG Selection Committee. When appointing athletes to these positions the Selection Committee may consider all or some of the following factors (not listed in any order of priority) and may give such

weight to any or all of these factors as the Selection Committee in its complete discretion sees fit:

- (i) Results at nominated selection event(s)
- (ii) Past National & International results (over the preceding 6 months)
- (vi) Possible future team composition, athlete attitude/behaviour and training consistency
- (vii) Any accepted special consideration applications

4.3 up to 4 athletes to be appointed for each camp, being ‘Visiting Athletes’. The WAG Selection Committee may appoint athlete(s) to the remaining positions considering all or some of the following factors (not listed in any order of priority) and may give such weight to any or all of these factors as the Selection Committee in its complete discretion sees fit:

- (i) Results at nominated selection event(s)
- (ii) Past National & International results (over the preceding 6 months)
- (vi) Possible future team composition, athlete attitude/behaviour and training consistency
- (vii) Any accepted special consideration applications
