

## How to Register for a FIG Course

## A FIG Course in Australia

- Gymnastics Australia will advertise all FIG courses:
  - o on the GA website
  - o in the Technical Member Bulletin
- Complete the Expression of Interest Application form and return this to education@gymnastics.org.au
- GA will email you to advise if you have been accepted on the course. GA will rank applicants. Numbers on a FIG course can be up to 20 participants.
- Course costs vary depending on the location of the course. You will be provided with 2 options:
  - Accommodation, meals and travel in the host city
  - Meals and travel in the host city only
- Participants will be responsible for travel costs to and from the host city.

## A FIG Course in New Zealand

- Gymnastics Australia will advertise all FIG courses:
  - on the GA website
  - o in the Technical Member Bulletin
- Complete the Expression of Interest Application form and return this to education@gymnastics.org.au
- GA will email you to advise if you have been accepted on the course. GA will rank applicants based on eligibility and priority. Expected numbers on a NZ based course are 5 participants.
- Course costs vary depending on the location of the course. You will be provided with 2 options:
  - Accommodation, meals and travel in the host city
  - Meals and travel in the host city only
- Participants will be responsible for travel costs to and from the host city.
