

2020 National Clubs Virtual Carnival FAQ

Will there be a prize for the winning club?

Yes. We are currently working on securing a prize for the winning club. We will make an announcement on our social media when we know more.

How will the finalist be selected?

Finalist will be shortlisted based on the specific criteria (see below).

A team of 5 Gymnastics Australia (GA) staff will select the 16 winners who will proceed to the next round.

Where there is a tie, a nominated GA representative will be asked to view and provide another score.

What are the judging criteria?

The video should be a creative reflection and celebration of how your club embodies the four F's of gymnastics; fun, fitness, friendship and fundamental movement.

It should:

- Be creative and innovative. Think outside the box.
- Incorporate the themes of fun, fitness, friendship and fundamental movement.
- Use of own environment, whether that be a gym floor, backyard, park or beach
- Minimal use of fixed-gymnastics specific equipment aside from a Gymnastics Floor (if desired) or mats.
- Feature as many gymnasts as possible as this is an opportunity, relative to the size of the club

Each criterion will be scored out of five, with the maximum score gainable a total 25

What apparatus is allowed to be used?

We encourage the use of Ribbons, Balls, Hoops and Clubs alongside other props such as household items, other sporting equipment etc.

There should be minimal use of fixed-gymnastics specific equipment aside from a Gymnastics Floor or mats.

Any entry using fixed equipment such as Balance Beams, High Bars, Pommel Horse, Still Rings, Vault, Uneven Bars, Parallel Bars will have points deducted.

How will the first-round match-ups work?

Once the top 16 videos are selected, clubs names will be entered into an online randomiser tool who will randomly select the first-round match-ups.

How will the fan-voting rounds of the competition work?

Once the first-round matchups are selected, each day two polls will be made available. One in the morning (10:30am AEST) and one in the afternoon (4:30pm AEST). At the conclusion of each voting round, the video with the most number of votes will progress to the next round.
